

GRANTS MANAGED BY EAST EUROPE FOUNDATION MOLDOVA IN 2023

1. Alliance of Organizations working with People with Disabilities (AOPD)

Project name – Local partnerships and national engagement for inclusion of people with disability / Parteneriate locale și implicare națională pentru incluziunea persoanelor cu dizabilități

Grant amount (2022) – MDL 482,080.00

Period of implementation: 15 March 2022 – 31 December 2022

The project seeks to increase social inclusion of people with disabilities from the Northern and Central regions of Moldova by strengthening the capacity of the members of the platform of Disabled People's Organisations (AOPD) to monitor and assess existing and emergent public policies. As a result, CSOs involved in a dialog with central and local authorities thus contributing to a better partnership and cooperation. The platform advocated for promoting documents on social inclusion program, action plan on accessibility measures and national employment strategy.

In 2022 the Platform for People with Disabilities monitored three public policies; contributed to • reduction of inequalities faced by people with disabilities; • enhanced implementation of inclusive education policies; • capacitation of the Platform's organizations to analyze and develop amendments to the legal framework.

2. HelpAge International

Project name – Integrarea îmbătrânirii active în politicile publice în Republica Moldova /

Integrating active aging into public policies in the Republic of Moldova

Grant amount (2022) – EUR 29,688.00

Period of implementation: 1 April 2022 – 31 December 2022

This project aims to prioritize advocacy topics in several areas of public policies: a) social assistance, namely social services for elderly, b) preventing and combating domestic violence against elderly women and men, c) active and healthy aging. In this regard, members of the Platform will organize activities to monitor implementation of the existing public policies, the level of acceptance and integration of previously formulated recommendations to improve the referenced public policy documents, but also initiation of emerging public policy developments. At the same time, members of the Platform will plan awareness-raising and advocacy campaigns to increase the level of information and decision-making at national and local level on the targeted public policy areas (social protection, prevention and combating violence, active and healthy aging). A special attention will be paid to implementation of advocacy activities for inclusion of the elderly-friendly activities into mentioned local public policy documents, including development and implementation of partnership with LPAs, local business plans on active and healthy aging principle.

In 2022 the Platform for Active Aging monitored two national policies; carried out mapping of social services in 3 selected localities; influenced emerging policies and decisions relevant for elderly on national and local levels; as well as mobilized and capacitated platform members in terms of public policies monitoring.

3. Voice of Roma Coalition/Coalitia Vocea Romilor

Project name –We promote policies sensitive to perspective of human rights and equal opportunities / Promovăm politici din perspectiva drepturilor omului și egalitatea de șanse

Grant amount (2022) – MDL 591,106.00

Period of implementation: 20 April 2022 – 31 December 2022

The project seeks to empower Roma communities, via their representatives, to take active and responsible role in decision-making process and solve the issues affecting Roma people at various

levels. Without their support and contribution, the new Roma Program 2022-2025 cannot be efficiently implemented. On the other hand, their involvement and participation contribute to joint actions on the longer term. This project aims to reduce poverty and increase economic potential, promote cultural diversity and combat existing negative stereotypes about Roma, as well as improve Roma participation in public life. The action aims to intervene with specific measures and responsibilities in such areas as education and community mediation.

Throughout 2022, members of the Roma Platform continued to monitor national policies, relevant for Roma people in the country, as well as contributed to approval of the Plan on Supporting Roma people for 2022-2025 contributed to: (i) inclusive pre-school and school education; (ii) employment of Roma people; (iii) mobilization of Roma population in localities to solve local problems.

4. Consiliul Național al Tineretului din Moldova (CNTM)/ Moldovan National Youth Council

Project name – Inițiativa Comună a Șanselor Egale pentru Tineri/ Joint Initiative for Equal Opportunities for Young People

Grant amount (2022) – MDL 521,134.00

Period of implementation: 15 March 2022 – 31 December 2022

The project aims to further strengthen the "Youth" advocacy group and involve young people in meaningful participation processes and the realization of a series of activities which will focus on integration of young people's priorities into existing sectoral policies as well as in ongoing monitoring and mapping of emerging public policies in order to ensure that needs and issues of young people are fully reflected in these documents. A special role in the project will be given to the strengthening of initiative groups and youth organizations outside Chisinau in identifying and solving local problems of young people.

During 2022 the project monitored two national policies, contributed to elaboration of the Youth Strategy in UTA Gagauzia.

5. DPC Cahul, secretariat "CONTACT – Cahul"

Project name – Consiliul Raional de Participare Cahul – platformă pentru un proces decizional transparent / Cahul District Participation Council – platform for a transparent decision-making process

Grant amount (2022) – MDL 500,000.00

Period of implementation: 1 April 2022 – 31 December 2022

The project aimed to further strengthen the capacity and role of the Cahul District Participation Council (DPC Cahul) in order to actively involve civil society in district decision-making processes by analyzing draft decisions, participation in the elaboration of inclusive public policies and monitoring of administrative transparency of the Cahul District Council (CDC). The positive results recorded in the previous phase should be strengthened by increasing the quality and efficiency of civil society involved into decision-making process of the Cahul District Council. Development of DPC Cahul and consolidation of this participatory platform is still an important exercise not only for civil society organizations, but also for the Cahul District Council, which, according to the law, serves the interest and needs of the citizens in Cahul district.

Additionally, significant efforts were made to capacitate DPC members in elaboration of analysis papers on draft decisions and public policies of local and national level. AS result of the project implementation, active participation of citizens and civil society in the decision-making process at the district level was fortified and responsibility and accountability of local officials and public officials in LPA II for qualitative, inclusive and comprehensive governance in Cahul district increased.

6. DPC Căușeni, secretariat "AP Tighina"

Project name – CRP Căușeni și Consiliul Raional Căușeni: parteneriat pentru un proces decizional transparent/ Căușeni District Participation Council and Căușeni District Council – a partnership for a transparent decision-making process

Grant amount (2022) – MDL 495,920.00

Period of implementation: 18 March 2022 – 31 December 2022

The project " Căușeni District Participation Council and Căușeni District Council – a partnership for a transparent decision-making process " aimed to further strengthen the efforts of CSOs in Causeni district - members of the Causeni District Participation Council and their community partners for local transmission of lucrative models of cooperation between LPA and citizens of Causeni district for improvement of governing act, transparency in actions of decision-makers who adopt local policies. The collaboration between DPC and LPA demonstrates capacity, availability, competence and continuous mobilization of these CSOs to continue influencing civil society of Causeni district to participate in decision-making process. DPC Causeni continues to be a viable mechanism in supporting marginalized categories, in ensuring participation of civil society in developing, implementing, monitoring, evaluating and reviewing public policies at the local level to support protection and inclusion of marginalized people.

In 2022, this project further coagulated the efforts of civil society to monitor the quality and transparency of local decisions; further strengthened capacity of the DPC to intervene with participative approach to decision making and advisers' opinions; motivated new NGOs to participate in meetings of the District Council, submitted proposals on improving draft decisions; enhance capacity to mobilize citizens to address the issues faced by marginalized groups. Particular attention was paid to informing citizens about local decision-making process via TV and radio broadcasts, publications and public debates with LPA representatives.

7. DPC Soroca, secretariat “Centrul de Resurse pentru Tineret „DACIA”

Grant amount (2022) – MDL 375,751.00

Period of implementation: 7 April 2022 – 31 December 2022

The project "Facilitating civic participation in the decision-making process" aims at further capacitation of the District Participation Council to be actively involved in the decision-making process of the Soroca District Council. The objectives of the project are focused on contributing to involvement of the District Participation Council, SCO and locals into monitoring of the governing act of the Soroca District Council and inclusive decision-making process, including consulting the decisions of major importance with the citizens of Soroca district. The project "Facilitating civic participation in the decision-making process" will help ensuring alternative transparency of the decision-making process of the Soroca District Council.

As result, in 2022 the project further implemented actions aimed to insure feasible, civic actions that increased capacity, competence and availability of civil society during primary level of experience in transparent and participatory decision-making processes in Soroca district. DPC strengthened the role of an alternative visibility of the decision-making process and information of ordinary citizens via all available means of media. This strategy proved very efficient and necessary to maintain and strengthen further on. During the fifth year of project implementation, the team of CRT Dacia focused on analysis of decisions of Soroca District Council, mobilized local SCOs and initiative groups, carried out evaluation of non-transparent decision-making .

In the context of the upcoming local elections, NGO Clubul Politic al Femeilor 50/50 and NGO Afina, under the umbrella of the Gender Equality Platform will empower 125 women belonging to vulnerable groups in five targeted districts (Călărași, Nisporeni, Căușeni, Leova și Rezina) to stand as candidates during the local elections. The implementing partners will increase the knowledge of 200 first time voters from Balti and Singerei on democratic processes and encourage them to vote. In addition, the grantees will raise awareness among political parties, development partners, media, civil society on the barriers faced by women belonging to vulnerable groups and corresponding solutions. The project is funded by Sweden.
