1. AO Centrul de Resurse al Organizațiilor Neguvernamentale pentru Drepturile Omului "CReDO"

Grant amount: **20,000.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 02/02/2015 – 29/02/2016

"Support for Anti-Corruption Alliance activities" is a project aiming to consolidate Anti-Corruption Alliance (ACA) and its member organizations as a feasible national platform for promoting and improving anti-corruption policies at central and local level. Through this project proposal, ACA by involving its members will organize a series of education and practice transfer activities and further on through concrete advocacy efforts will contribute to improving legal framework and practices within anti-corruption field. The funding for this initiative is provided by Sweden and Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Denmark.

2. AO "Synergetica Eur-Est"

Grant amount: **17,365.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 18/09/2015 – 17/11/2015

The project aims to boost the development of the civil society, by engaging the representatives of this sector and ordinary citizens in a new discussion platform – Civic Fest, which supports social entrepreneurship and social integration, community development through civic initiatives, socio-cultural transformations and social responsibility. Through this initiative, best European practices will be promoted and shared within a 2-days event organized in Orheiul Vechi with participation of Moldovan and European NGO representatives, businesses and international community. This way, civil society actors will become more active in the field, by developing and implementing new initiatives based on the experiences shared during the event. The project will foster the development of a multicultural and multidimensional communication platform for the actors of Moldovan civil society and their European counterparts. Period of implementation: 02/01/2015 – 30/06/2015

The project is designed to increase awareness and strengthen the understanding of the population from the Republic of Moldova about the benefits of the European Integration, as well as developing a positive perception of the citizens concerning the European Integration. The grantee will create a set of video products, audio, TV and radio to promote the idea of EU integration benefits to each person in Moldova by introducing some successful stories of people and institutions in the EU countries: Estonia, Lithuania, Poland and Romania. In a longer term, the initiative will lead to informed population from the country about European Integration and to an objective public perception on EU. The grantee will continue providing information and training activities at the European Interactive Center, which was established in 2006 in Comrat city. Targeting students, youth, women, teachers, local government officials, business groups, and other interested groups, the center will continue to act as a platform for information and discussion on issues related to European integration. As a result of the project, the public will be more informed and more engaged in EU-related issues such as EU affairs, work and education in EU countries, and EU regulations affecting Moldova. The action will contribute to the development of a positive citizens' perception on the European Integration path of the country. The grantee will conduct an information campaign on EU integration, including public debates and discussion clubs. ADEPT will monitor the political Titles of the AA and EXPERT-GRUP will oversee the implementation of economic Titles, including DCFTA. The project will set the stage for debates between civil society and government on authorities’ performance in implementing the Association Agreement. Monitoring results will be shared with the general public through periodic press conferences. The monitoring reports will also be Moldovan Government, Parliament and all the state institutions responsible for Association Agreement implementation. 10. AO Centru de Resurse ”Dialog Pro”

Grant amount: **925,000.00 MDL**

Period of implementation: 02/02/2015 – 31/12/2015

This project seeks to strengthen popular support for the European integration process of Moldova through coordinated civil society engagement. The grantee will ensure communication and exchange of information among the “Pro Europe” Platforms members, their counterparts and general public. The action enable the Civil Society Platform “Pro Europe” to efficiently implement an information campaign about the European path of Moldova and to raise capacities of its secretariat. The project will raise public awareness and access to information about the European path of the Republic of Moldova, the relations between EU and Moldova, as well as the implications of this path for Moldovan citizens. The grantee will contribute to greater acceptance by citizens of the European integration and gradual rapprochement of Moldova to the European values. 11. Asociația Businessului European

Period of implementation: 17/09/2015 – 31/01/2016

The project is designed to improve the level of awareness and knowledge of the private sector representatives on DCFTA and Foreign Trade onto the EU Market. The grantee will empower the companies to access the EU market through practical support on foreign trade by offering training to up to 300 importers and exporters on DCFTA related issues. The project will also contribute to increasing the responsibility of national authorities in the process of DCFTA implementation by means of supporting 4 sectoral business committees to identify current issues and submit pertinent recommendations to corresponding state bodies. The grantee will also increase awareness on DCFTA opportunities by organizing a national conference bringing together the importers and exporters from the Republic of Moldova and national authorities. Period of implementation: 01/12/2015 – 30/09/2016

The project is designed to increase the access of media consumers to information about local initiatives that have a positive impact on communities. The grantee will achieve the following outputs: (i) build the capacity of journalists of the www.stiripozitive.eu to reflect public interest information; (ii) increase coverage of information about local initiative and success stories at the local level; (iii) promote the concept of positive local initiatives among LPAs, businesses, information consumers. In the long run, the project will change media culture to become more user oriented and expand consumers' access to unbiased and public interest information. The funding for this initiative is provided by Sweden.

13. Alianța Centrelor Comunitare de Acces la Informație și Instruire din Moldova

Grant amount: **13,493.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 18/05/2015 – 16/09/2015

The goal of the project is to promote the access of all persons with disabilities to the local general elections due on 14 June 2015. In cooperation with other member organisations of the Civic Coalition for Free and Fair Elections, the grantee will provide support to the persons with physical, visual and hearing disabilities to exercise their right to vote and participate as independent observers in the elections. The project will provide assistance to the Central Electoral Commission in ensuring the accessibility of information for persons with hearing disabilities. The action will sensitise political parties and media on the issues faced by the persons with disabilities and mobilise them to act in order to address them. In addition, the grantee will involve the general public in monitoring the accessibility of polling stations through the Ushahidi-based online platform. The funding for this initiative is provided by Sweden.

14. IP "Centrul pentru Jurnalism Independent"

Grant amount: **10,100.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 18/05/2015 – 17/08/2015

The goal of the project is to promote free and fair elections in Moldova by monitoring media behavior during the 2015 local general elections. The grantee will monitor the way 10 targeted media institutions respect deontological standards, including gender equality. The project will inform the public about the behavior of the media during the general elections of 2015 and to raise awareness of the international community on cases of press freedom abuse. In addition, the action will contribute to encouraging and improving diversity and quality of Moldovan media's election coverage. The funding for this initiative is provided by Sweden.

15. AO "Promo-LEX"

Grant amount: **22,574.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 21/12/2015 – 19/08/2016

The goal of the project is to contribute to the respect of the electoral rights of citizens through the analysis of legal disputes from the 2014 and 2015 elections. The analysis will ensure an analytical basis for the lobby and advocacy initiatives that would amend the legal framework and improve the current practices. In addition, the initiative will contribute to the development of effective training programs in this area for judges and other relevant actors. The funding for this initiative is provided by Sweden.

16. AO "Clubul Politic al Femeilor – 50/50"

Grant amount: **79,085.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 01/03/2015 – 30/09/2016

The project is designed to boost political participation of women in five regions of Moldova. In partnership with local NGOs, the grantee will create women's political clubs in five territorial administrative units. The clubs will conduct round tables, participatory nomination campaigns, workshops with women from vulnerable groups, trainings for women members of the Clubs who wish to run for local Elections 2015 and those who were nominated in participative nomination campaign, as well as awareness raising campaign for women voters. The long term result is a better political representation of women, more women actively participating the political and public life of their community, and the voice of all women heard. The funding for this initiative is provided by Sweden through United Nations Entity for Gender Equality and the Empowerment of Women - UNWOMEN within the project "Women in Politics".

17. AO “Meridian”

Grant amount: **9,940.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 11/05/2015 – 10/08/2015

The project aims to encourage women from rural areas to take part in the decision-making process. The grantee will increase the visibility of women in 10 localities during the pre and post-electoral periods. The project will promote gender equality and gender policies by means of 10 TV shows. In addition, the action will strengthen the capacity of 10 journalists to report on gender equality issues. The funding for this initiative is provided by Sweden through United Nations Entity for Gender Equality and the Empowerment of Women - UNWOMEN within the project “Women in Politics”.

18. AO “V.I.P” a Telejurnaliștilor Independenți din RM

Grant amount: **10,000.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 13/05/2015 – 12/02/2016

The project aims to increase the representation of women in political parties, central and local public administration. The grantee will develop and broadcast media products that will raise awareness on the importance of gender equality and increase pressure on decision makers to address the issue. The project will produce TV and Radio programs, thematic pages in printed newspapers, reflecting the issues that cause gender imbalances in politics, central and local public administration and corresponding solutions. The funding for this initiative is provided by Sweden through United Nations Entity for Gender Equality and the Empowerment of Women - UNWOMEN within the project “Women in Politics”.

19. AO “VESTA”

Grant amount: **9,415.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 13/05/2015 – 12/11/2015

The project aims to strengthen the political participation of women from the Southern region of the Republic of Moldova. The grantee will select and build the leadership capacity of 20 women from the South of Moldova. The project will contribute to the establishment of a positive attitude regarding the role of women in politics by preparing and broadcasting on TV. The funding for this initiative is provided by Sweden through United Nations Entity for Gender Equality and the Empowerment of Women - UNWOMEN within the project “Women in Politics”.

20. AO “Gender Centru”

Grant amount: **7,886.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 13/05/2015 – 31/12/2015

The project aims to establish a friendly and sensitive environment for gender equality in Moldova. Project will train and encourage women to run as candidates in the local elections due on 14 June 2015. The grantee will conduct complex awareness raising activities on gender equality, including via a TV talk show, regional debates, a photo exhibition. The project will also advocate by the National Gender Equality Commission for the establishment of gender quota. The funding for this initiative is provided by Sweden through United Nations Entity for Gender Equality and the Empowerment of Women - UNWOMEN within the project “Women in Politics”.

21. AO Centrul de Resurse “Tineri și Liberi”

Grant amount: **43,415.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 13/05/2015 – 30/09/2016

The project aims to mobilize the civil society, within the Gender Equality Platform, to exercise public pressure on political leaders and MPs for adopting in the second reading of the legislative package on the gender quotas. The grantee will host the secretariat of the gender equality platform and will

ensure proper coordination and communication within the network. In collaboration with other NGOs, the grantee will carry out innovative public actions to promote women in politics, meeting the decision-makers and awareness raising for promoting gender equality in politics. The funding for this initiative is provided by Sweden through United Nations Entity for Gender Equality and the Empowerment of Women - UNWOMEN within the project “Women in Politics”.

22. AO “Asociația Comunitară Locală Pepeni”

Grant amount: **5,907.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 13/05/2015 – 30/11/2015

The project aims to promote active women participation in the general local elections due in summer of 2015. The action will encourage women from Pepeni village to participate as candidates in the elections through a participatory nomination campaign. The initiative will facilitate the dialogue between the 20 nominated women and political parties. The nominated women will mobilise the community to solve environmental issues. In this way, the project will also contribute to changing the mentality about the role of women in society. The funding for this initiative is provided by Sweden through United Nations Entity for Gender Equality and the Empowerment of Women - UNWOMEN within the project “Women in Politics”.

23. AO “Asociația Comunitară Locală Singerei Noi”

Grant amount: **7,948.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 13/05/2015 – 12/11/2015

The project aims to encourage participation of women from Singereii Noi village to run as candidates in the June 2015 local general elections. The grantee will organize a participatory nomination campaign of at least 20 women and facilitate their interaction with political parties registered in the elections. During the post-electoral period the nominated women will mobilise the community to arrange the park from Marinesti, part of Singereii Noi village. The funding for this initiative is provided by Sweden through United Nations Entity for Gender Equality and the Empowerment of Women - UNWOMEN within the project “Women in Politics”.

24. AO “Femeia Modernă”

Grant amount: **5,354.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 13/05/2015 – 12/08/2015

The project aims to establish a friendly and sensitive environment for gender equality in Moldova. The grantee will train and encourage 240 women to run as candidates in the local elections due on 14 June 2015. The initiative will raise awareness in 12 communities surrounded to Orhei, Soldanesti and Rezina districts about the role of women in politics. During the post-election period the project will increase the capacity of 60 elected women from targeted localities on the management of the LPA. The funding for this initiative is provided by Sweden through United Nations Entity for Gender Equality and the Empowerment of Women - UNWOMEN within the project “Women in Politics”.

25. AO Uniunea Tinerilor Romi ”TARNA ROM”

Grant amount: **8,955.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 13/05/2015 – 12/09/2015

The project aims to enhance the participation of Roma women in the electoral and political process. The grantee will train 100 Roma women from 8 localities in the area of designing and implementing a political campaign. The project will contribute to raising the civic conscience of people in targeted communities through awareness raising activities on the importance of voting, electoral rights and procedures. The funding for this initiative is provided by Sweden through United Nations Entity for Gender Equality and the Empowerment of Women - UNWOMEN within the project “Women in Politics”.

26. AO "Sens Muzical"

Grant amount: **4,900.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 25/05/2015 – 24/06/2015

The project is designed to empower Butuceni community from Orhei region around socio-economic development through the opera concert in the air with the National Opera from Chisinau and Master Friedrich Pfeiffer, Viena. In partnership with other organizations, the grantee will organize the concert in Butuceni, strengthening linkages between inhabitants and various actors from the field of agro-tourism, crafts, and artists and carry out various promotion activities for a higher visibility of the festival. Communities will also be mobilized to promote a healthier environment, through an arranged touristic and cultural route. The project will foster the development of a cross-cultural communication platform for rural tourism entrepreneurs, craftspeople, artists, local and international tourists for the establishment of commercial and partnership relations with potential investors and will help promote healthier leisure time spending for visitors.
