Grant amount: **38,881.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 01/03/2016 – 31/12/2016

The project aims to empower people in five targeted communities to get involved in community life in order to strengthen quality of governance and to address local development needs. EEF will support the efforts of NGO Dialog-Pro on creating five Clubs of Active Citizens partnering with LPA in addressing community issues using human rights principles of equality, non-discrimination, transparency, participation and democratic governance. The Project activities strive to ensure the citizen's right to local governance through prioritizing local needs and increasing LPA's transparency and accountability. The funding for this initiative is provided by Sweden and Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Denmark.

The project aims to improve the quality of social services, to ensure an environment of active living for older people in Costesti community, offering assistance and specialized support for social information, occupational therapy and leisure, and reducing some vulnerable situations for older people and increasing awareness and participation of the local community to support elderly people to an independent life and dignity. The project provides for the creation of an organization of volunteer children to be friends of children with special needs. The schools will create a favorable psychological environment, support and encouragement for children with disabilities and special needs. Through their work, the volunteers will give all students from schools such supportive and tolerant behavior towards their peers with special needs. This will lead to the reduction of discrimination by their peers. The funding for this initiative is provided by Sweden and Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Denmark.

### **33. AO "Centrul Psiho-social"**

Period of implementation: 03/02/2016 – 02/12/2016

The project aims to facilitate the inclusion of children with disabilities (CD) and children with special educational requirements in the school environment by reducing the phenomenon of discrimination by their peers. The funding for this initiative is provided by Sweden and Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Denmark.

### **34. AO "Oameni pentru Oameni"**

NGO Association of Deaf Children from Moldova will carry out a training program on Social Entrepreneurship, Human Rights, vocational courses, including employment opportunities for young people with special needs, especially for those with hearing impairments. The organization will inform and consult the beneficiaries to find certain solutions to facilitate their social integration. The initiative will contribute to raising awareness among young people with special needs providing more employment opportunities for young people.
