Project name: "Access to legal services for everyone "

Grant amount: **12,347.00 EUR**

Period of implementation: 20/03/2018 – 19/09/2019

The goal of the project is to improve the access of population from Tiraspol, Bender and Slobozia to free legal assistance services, as well as improvement population legal education through the establishment of a legal assistance center opened for each citizen facing different problems. This initiative will lead to new opportunities of protecting citizens' rights, will upper the legal education of the population and will consolidate the legal culture amongst the citizens. The funding for this initiative is provided by the European Union and Sweden within the project "Building bridges, facing challenges".

2. НП Информационно-правовой Центр "Виалекс"

Project name: "Legal Assistance Center in Rybnita"

Grant amount: **13,192.00 EUR**

Period of implementation: 20/03/2018 – 19/09/2019

The goal of the project is to improve the access of vulnerable groups of population to legal assistance in the field of family, labor, housing law, as well as in civil law through the establishment of a legal assistance center in Rybnitsa town. Through this project, the beneficiaries are able to identify situations that require protection and seek help to protect their rights from the relevant partners - lawyers, journalists, human rights NGOs and state profile institutions. The goal of the project is to improve the access of population from Grigoriopol town and Grigoriopol and Dubasari rayons to legal assistance, as well as improvement of free legal assistance and population legal education through the establishment of a legal assistance center opened for each citizen facing different problems. The funding for this initiative is provided by the European Union and Sweden within the project "Building bridges, facing challenges".

Project name: "Joint Initiative for Equal Chances for Youth"

Period of implementation: 02/01/2018 – 31/12/2019

The project aims at strengthening the youth advocacy group created in 2016-2017 in order to design and implement the advocacy pan for mainstreaming youth priorities into the existing and emerging sectorial policies. The project will enable the youth NGO platform to mobilize for addressing the needs of young people in three regions (Basarabeasca, Ocnita and UTA Gagauzia). The funding for this project is provided by the Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation and Sweden within "The Joint Equal Opportunity Initiative".

The project seeks to increase social inclusion of persons with disabilities from the Northern and Central regions of Moldova by strengthening the capacity of the members of the platform of Disabled People's Organizations (AOPD) to monitor and assess existing and emergent public policies. As a result, CSOs will involve in a dialog with central and local authorities thus contributing for a better partnership and cooperation. The platform will advocate for promoting documents on social inclusion program, action plan on accessibility measures and national strategy employment strategy. The funding for this project is provided by the Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation and Sweden within "The Joint Equal Opportunity Initiative".

6. HelpAge International

Project name: "Integration of active aging in public policies in Moldova"

Period of implementation: 02/01/2018 – 31/12/2019

The project aims to mainstream the needs of and opportunities for active ageing in public policies. The project will strengthen the group of organizations active in the field of promoting older people rights, engaging them in advocacy activities. The platform will also work at the local level to identify the social needs of older people. The policy analyses will be accompanied with corresponding recommendations and policy proposals for the meaningful inclusion of older people and their needs in order to ensure opportunities for active ageing for every citizen of the country. As a result of project implementation a dialog will be established between CSOs and state institutions in order to prioritize issues regarding ageing population and to ensure development of coherent and sustainable public policies. 7. Uniunea Tinerilor Romi din Republica Moldova "Tărnă Rom"

Project name: "Step by step solutions for Roma in Moldova – Roma Voice Coalition"

Grant amount: **346,873.00 MDL**

Period of implementation: 02/01/2018 – 31/12/2019

Current project aims at increasing level of participation and inclusion of roma people into social life in the Republic of Moldova, through advocacy and lobby campaigns, analyzing emerging documents and acting in the communities. The policy analyses will have certain recommendations and proposals for the meaningful inclusion of roma people and their needs. As a result of project implementation a dialog will be established between CSOs and state institutions in order to prioritize issues regarding roma population and to ensure development of coherent and sustainable public policies. The funding for this project is provided by the Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation and Sweden within "The Joint Equal Opportunity Initiative".

8. AO "Prima"

Project name: "Development of Local Partnerships for socio-economic inclusion of socially vulnerable people"

Grant amount: **24,000.00 EUR**

Period of implementation: 01/11/2018 – 30/04/2020

The project will facilitate the access of socially vulnerable people from Taraclia district to improved and efficient employment services through developing a partnership for the coordination and consolidation of cross-sectoral structures and by creating a platform for promoting socio-economic inclusion of vulnerable people. The purpose of the platform is to bring initiatives to local legislative bodies for sustainable socio-economic inclusion of socially vulnerable people. The funding for this initiative is

provided by the European Union and Sweden within the project "Local civil society contributes to economic and social development".

9. AO "AZI"

Project name: "Local civil society contributes to economic and social development in Moldova"

Grant amount: **24,000.00 EUR**

Period of implementation: 01/11/2018 – 31/10/2019

The association will take over the Assisted Employment model, which is being applied in the EU Member States, and for 5 years has been successfully implemented in the Republic of Moldova by the Association "Motivation". The project activities are oriented to train AOFM staff and LPA specialists in the implementation of the "Assisted Employment (AE)" methodology to support the inclusion of people with disabilities in the labor market and to raise awareness and motivate employers to hire people with disabilities in the context of local labor shortages. Through this project, the Assisted Employment model will be replicated in two districts of the South-Republic of Moldova: Cahul and Cantemir. The funding for this initiative is provided by the European Union and Sweden within the project "Local civil society contributes to economic and social development".

10. AO "Dorinta"

Project name: "Local partnerships to facilitate the employment of people with disabilities"

Grant amount: **24,000.00 EUR**

Period of implementation: 01/11/2018 – 31/10/2019

The project aims to empower 50 people with disabilities from Călărași by training them in various practical workshops (tailoring, culinary, IT, personal development). In parallel, the assessment of job adaptation for people with disabilities will be carried out in 7 public and private sector institutions from Călărași district. Representatives of public and private institutions will be aware of the difficulties and the advantages of employing people with disabilities. Within the project will be strengthened the partnership with AOFM Călărași in order to facilitate the employment of people with disabilities in the labor market. The funding for this initiative is provided by the European Union and Sweden within the project "Local civil society contributes to economic and social development".

11. AO "Asociația Psihologilor Tighina"

Project name: "Inter-sectoral partnerships for the integration of the disadvantaged young people from the Causeni and Stefan Voda rayons"

Grant amount: **24,000.00 EUR**

Period of implementation: 01/11/2018 – 31/01/2020

The project will contribute to creation of new mechanisms of cooperation between community actors and LPAs in facilitating safer access to quality social services for vulnerable people - young people in difficulty. The project involves vocational empowerment and insertion on the labor market of at least 25 young beneficiaries from Căușeni and Ștefan Vodă through support in personal development, employment and the initiation of at least 5 income-generating activities. As a result, LPAs will take models over management of income generating activities launched within the project by piloting the 1 + 1 mechanism (for each revenue-generating activity funded under the project, the LPA will finance one from own sources, in total 10 income-generating activities per project will be launched). Thus, the project will serve as a model for inter-sectoral community cooperation in supporting vulnerable groups of young men and women in rural communities - a good practice that can be replicated in the region. The funding for this initiative is provided by the European Union and Sweden within the project "Local civil society contributes to economic and social development".

Project name: "Un locușor sub soare cu mîinele proprii"

Grant amount: **19,895.00 EUR**

Period of implementation: 01/11/2018 – 31/10/2019

The project will contribute to creation of new mechanisms of cooperation between community actors and LPAs in facilitating safer access to quality social services for vulnerable people - people with disabilities. The project involves vocational empowerment and insertion on the labor market of at least 20 young beneficiaries from Caragaş village, Transnistria Region through support in personal development, development of practical abilities in handmade products and employment. The funding for this initiative is provided by the European Union and Sweden within the project "Local civil society contributes to economic and social development".

COMPONENT 1.3: Free, fair and inclusive elections

13. AO "Asociația pentru Democrație Participativă"

Project name: "Free and Fair Elections Coalition 2018"

Grant amount: **25,000.00 EUR**

Period of implementation: 02/04/2018 – 31/01/2019

The project seeks to contribute to free, fair and inclusive elections in 2018, compliant with the international electoral standards and the human rights commitments of Moldova. In the context of the 2018 Parliamentary Elections, the grantee will host the secretariat of the Civic Coalition for Free and Fair Elections (Coalition) - a platform that unites approximately 50 NGOs. The Secretariat will facilitate internal and external communication of the Coalition members, ensuring its good functioning. The project will strengthen the communication and outreach capacities of the Coalition. The initiative will facilitate civil society advocacy for democratic elections, ensuring that continuous awareness of citizens, electoral bodies, electoral candidates, donors and other relevant stakeholders about the 2018 Parliamentary suffrage. The funding for this initiative is provided by the European Union and Sweden within the project "Civil Society Advocacy for inclusive and fair elections in the Republic of Moldova, compliant with EU and OSCE/ODIHR recommendations and human rights commitments".

COMPONENT 2.1: Community Mobilization and Consumer Protection

14. AO Clubul Sportiv "SKATEBOARDING"

Project name: "Skating the bridges, skating the obstacles"

Grant amount: **10,000.00 EUR**

Period of implementation: 10/10/2018 – 10/06/2019

The project aims to join teams on both banks which will be practicing skateboarding, but also participating in competitions and events, boys and girls from both banks of Nistru River, but also with foreign skaters invited to the events (from Romania, France, Ukraine, USA, etc). They will work as one team and will be part of a united community, and thus will increase mutual confidence and trust. The actions in the project are aimed at encouraging the development in Moldova and Transnistria, of an open-mind, motivated and integrated generation, based on modern socio-cultural values, through practicing alternative and modern sport activities and participating in various socio-cultural events, generating motivation, socio-cultural integration, health, but also professional athletes. The funding for this initiative is provided by the European Union and Sweden within the project "Building bridges, facing challenges".

15. AO "Asociația Națională de Tratament Paliativ

Project name: "Estimating needs for palliative care services in Transnistria"

Grant amount: **9,507.00 EUR**

Period of implementation: 10/10/2018 – 09/04/2019

The purpose of the project is to estimate the palliative care needs on the left bank of the Nistru. The activities planned in the project are the collection of statistical data on population mortality from the Ministry of Health and the hospitals of districts in the left bank of the Nistru River and their analysis. Subsequently, the draft provides for the elaboration of recommendations for applying the most optimal model for providing incurable patients with palliative care. An estimate will also be made of the costs necessary for the provision of IP services in the Transnistrian region. Finally, the project coordinators will present the results in a round table and will ensure their media coverage. The funding for this initiative is provided by the European Union and Sweden within the project "Building bridges, facing challenges".

16. AO "Asociația Psihologilor Tighina" in partnership with AO "Rodoliubet"

Project name: "Community Development in the Nistral Males - in Action"

Grant amount: **9,995.00 EUR**

Period of implementation: 11/10/2018 – 10/06/2019

The project seeks to strengthen the community partnership to solve priority problems through citizen participation on both sides of the Nistru. The civic education component of the community through participation in democratic processes in society aims to empower the community to implement initiatives, develop intersectoral partnerships, combine efforts through the participation of LPAs and other stakeholders interested in the prosperity of the community. Special emphasis will be placed on volunteer activities by community leaders identified and trained to bring change into the community and represent a trustworthy resource for the community. The project involves the replication of good practices on both banks of the Nistru, an experience that is ongoing and successful for the current partners. The funding for this initiative is provided by the European Union and Sweden within the project "Building bridges, facing challenges".

17. Fundația de Binefacere "Caritas Moldova"

Project name: "The theater that unites us in solving common problems"

Grant amount: **10,000.00 EUR**

Period of implementation: 11/10/2018 – 10/10/2019

This project aims at promotion of human rights among adolescents at risk through Social Theater methods in Chisinau and Tiraspol. By means of Social Theater, this project will allow children to learn about their rights and learn how to defend them through playing roles. Theater participants who are graduates of boarding schools, teenagers from families at risk and volunteers will be able to independently choose topics that they care about, play them out and show them to others. Social theater is a platform where young people will be able to use their legal knowledge and communication skills. Children will be able to defend their rights and interests, openly express their opinions and take an active civic stand. Through such online learning, adolescents will be able to transmit the received information to their peers and other people.

Also, within the framework of the project in Tiraspol, individual legal support by a lawyer will be provided, which will help adolescents solve their problems related to legal issues (placing on a waiting list for housing, documentation, registration, debt on utility bills, social assistance, benefits, etc.) that will improve their quality of life. The funding for this initiative is provided by the European Union and Sweden within the project "Building bridges, facing challenges".

18. AO Centrul de Asistență Socială „Casa Speranțelor”

Project name: "Together Overcome Barriers"

Grant amount: **9,979.00 EUR**

Period of implementation: 11/10/2018 – 10/04/2019

The project aims to promote the rights of people with disabilities and to inform citizens on both sides of the Nistru about the ways of defending these rights, developing local partnerships, enhancing collaboration between citizens and authorities. Also, the project will be supported by partner organizations in identifying internal and external donors, members of organizations will develop their abilities to develop, implement and monitor projects. They will promote models of good practice in addressing local issues and community development. There will be 2 thematic workshops: "Project Management" and "Project Life Cycle". The project also involves the organization of sports competitions in torball, golball, table tennis, chess and game, exchange of experience in solving the problems of different disadvantaged groups, which will lay the foundation for creating a socialization platform between citizens on both sides, but and interaction with the society they live in. As a result of active involvement in community life, trust between civil society organizations and local public administration on both sides of the Nistru will be increased. The funding for this initiative is provided by the European Union and Sweden within the project "Building bridges, facing challenges".

19. AO "Centrul pentru Dezvoltare Socio-Economică și Susținere a Antreprenoriatului Inovațional"

Project name: "Waste Connect - Integrated Waste Treatment System in the Nistru Basin"

Grant amount: **9,992.00 EUR**

Period of implementation: 11/10/2018 – 10/07/2019

The project "WasteConnect - Integrated Waste Management System in the Nistru Basin" aims to strengthen a common ecosystem in the field of solid waste recycling and processing on both banks of the Nistru, by implementing activities to ensure the exchange of experience between actors on both banks. As a result, collaboration partnerships between private sector representatives and civil society are envisaged with the purpose of formulating a common mechanism for the integration of the Solid Waste Management, Recycling and Processing Process. The funding for this initiative is provided by the European Union and Sweden within the project "Building bridges, facing challenges".

20. AO Centrul de Educație Nonformală "Diversitate"

Project name: "Building bridges - steps to meet people2people"

Grant amount: **9,971.00 EUR**

Period of implementation: 10/10/2018 – 30/03/2019

The project is planned as a civic campaign of consecutive actions and activities, involving partners and participants on the both banks of Nistru, and aimed to facilitate collaborative work between young people from Moldova and Transnistria (including representatives of vulnerable and marginalized groups). It will empower them with experience of civic participation, using creative skills, knowledge and tools basing on human rights concept, non-discrimination, democracy values, and diversity.

The main project result will be the establishment of network of young, active and motivated people from both banks of the Nistru, who will receive experience of community needs-oriented work and community building and shared values of human rights and non-discrimination, equality, diversity, active citizenship, as well as the increase in the level of mutual trust as well as confidence building between these representatives, overcoming existing stereotypes and prejudices. The funding for this initiative is provided by the European Union and Sweden within the project "Building bridges, facing challenges".

21. Fundația Filantropică Medico-Socială "Angelus Moldova"

Project name: "Initiation of Stomatherapy Services in the Left Bank of Nistru river"

Grant amount: **9,771.00 EUR**

Period of implementation: 10/10/2018 – 09/04/2019

The project aims to offer assistance in introducing the practice of stoma therapy consultations and to cover an existing gap in the left bank of the Nistru river in this field. There are about 100 stoma patients in Transnistria who need monthly stomp bags, as well as advice and information on the use of bags, stomach care, proper nutrition, etc. Through the activities provided in Tiraspol (training with patients and / or their relatives, a conference with international participation for medical staff and a roundtable with health decision-makers in Transnistria) and by providing information materials, the project will contribute to improving the quality of life of stoma patients, and their relatives. In addition, the right and left experts of the Nistru will be able to know better and, through co-operation, find solutions to the common challenges. The funding for this initiative is provided by the European Union and Sweden within the project "Building bridges, facing challenges".

22. AO "IEDERA-Dubăsarii Vechi" in partnership with AO "Active World"

Project name: "Initiation of Stomatherapy Services in the Left Bank of Nistru river"

Grant amount: **9,996.00 EUR**

Period of implementation: 10/10/2018 – 07/03/2019

Young people on both sides of the Nistru will have the opportunity to get involved and to affirm themselves personally through common events, to acquire and / or develop personal skills, to participate together in the socio-cultural and sports activities organized in both localities, to know traditions and customs, as well as those specific to a locality. They will promote a healthy lifestyle and learn together the hand-made technique of different objects in different traditional styles of the decorative and applied art locality. Young people from Dubasarii Vechi village and Lunga Dubasari will have the opportunity to participate in the photo contest of their native settlements. Through these activities, they will reflect on the most important local resources and the way that modern life flows on both banks of the Nistru. The funding for this initiative is provided by the European Union and Sweden within the project "Building bridges, facing challenges".

23. AO "Floresitas" in partnership with Благотворительный Фонд «Дари Добро»

Project name: "Children Against Borders"

Grant amount: **9,975.00 EUR**

Period of implementation: 10/10/2018 – 09/02/2019

The project consists of organizing 4 musical workshops with children and students from both banks of the Nistru, having social and cultural meaning, culminating them in a common musical concert held in Tiraspol in the run up to Christmas in the City Palace of Culture. The workshops will include a musical performance carried out by Geta Burlacu and a small orchestra (3 instruments), based on music hits, Christmas songs, breathing techniques, and music exercises.

The music program, learned by the workshop participants under the guidance of Geta Burlacu, will become the basis for a final concert. Gala concert also will include performance of youth musical teams from both banks. In order to provide maximum transparency and gain wide attention on both Nistru banks, various marketing campaigns, as well as media and social media coverage will have a special place in the project. Cooperating with local administration and Tiraspol's cultural community is another valuable component of this initiative.

The main element of these seminars is music therapy, which includes a wide range of stress relieving properties and incorporates the attendees into the musical show as an improvised chorus. The exploration of artistic abilities, emotional liberation and bonding with strangers while being unified in a single musical entity is only the surface scope of this workshop. The project's main aim is confidence building and uniting children on both Nistru banks through cultural connections and opportunities for cooperation. The funding for this initiative is provided by the European Union and Sweden within the project "Building bridges, facing challenges".

24. AO "Centrul de Instruire în Domeniul Sănătății Reproductive"

Project name: "Better and more accessible reproductive health medical services for people with disabilities from both banks of the Nistru river"

Grant amount: **9,998.00 EUR**

Period of implementation: 11/10/2018 – 10/05/2019

The goal of the project is to increase awareness of sexual and reproductive rights of women and girls with disabilities in Moldova and Transnistria, enable them to exercise these rights and to take informed decisions regarding their own sexuality. In order to achieve the goal of the project, the following activities will be undertaken: One-day training for 15 girls with disabilities from Tiraspol to build their capacity to exercise their sexual and reproductive rights, use the referral system created for them, increase confidence and self-esteem in order to be able to make better and informed decisions. Another planned activity is a one-day training on how to address the SRH of persons with disabilities for medical staff from the two centers participating in the project. Additionally, the existing compartment related to sexual and reproductive rights on RHTC web/Facebook will be completed with new resources, evidence-based data/information related to persons with disabilities, including in the Russian language. Finally, there will be a dissemination workshop about the results of the project. It will be aimed at increasing the awareness and commitment of local authorities and community to respect and protect sexual and reproductive rights of people with disabilities. The funding for this initiative is provided by the European Union and Sweden within the project "Building bridges, facing challenges".

25. AO "Trigon"

Project name: "Art as an Instrument for Strengthening the Society and as a Development Factor of the Regions"

Grant amount: **6,971.00 EUR**

Period of implementation: 11/10/2018 – 10/12/2019

The purpose of the project with the participation of artists from Switzerland, Poland and Moldova, is the consolidation of the society in the Republic of Moldova. In the current period, strengthening society is the main condition that would stimulate the economic, social, political and cultural development of a multinational country. Direct cooperation between artistic higher education institutions by organizing

lessons and workshops in the Tiraspol music colleges, Balti, Soroca. The project is designed to promote the cultural sovereignty of the contemporary world, to provide the general public in the capital and regional cities with an artistic and educational program promoting ethical values of democratic society, as well as professional values for young musicians and students from institutions education in Moldova. The funding for this initiative is provided by the European Union and Sweden within the project "Building bridges, facing challenges".

26. AO "Viitorul Copiilor Noștri" VICON in partnership with Благотворительный Фонд «Сердце»

Project name: "STEM Education in Moldova"

Grant amount: **9,983.00 EUR**

Period of implementation: 10/10/2018 – 09/10/2019

The main objective of the project is to promote partnership and strengthen the capacity of public organizations VICON and the Charitable Foundation Heart, the formation of a civil society. The project brings together volunteers from Moldova (including the Transnistrian region) and uses a "low-politics" approach to foster cooperation between the two banks of the Nistru.

One of the key points of the project will be the creation of a cross-border network of STEM groups (an abbreviation for Science, Technology, Engineering, Design, Mathematics) which will ensure the transfer of best practices throughout the region. The groups will be coordinated by two STEM Starting Centers on both banks of the Nistru. It will include research, capacity development, study visits, online events and support for collaborative development initiatives. Thanks to the promotion of Human Rights in practice, combining scattered natural-science knowledge into a single whole, cooperation between the public organization VICON and the Charitable Foundation Heart will be fruitfully developed. The joint initiative will be implemented in the field of promoting human rights through mathematics and the natural sciences, which are studied in practice in close connection with real life. The funding for this initiative is provided by the European Union and Sweden within the project "Building bridges, facing challenges".

The goal of the project is to increase the level of consumers legal knowledge of and the level of involvement of citizens in the defense of their rights in the field of food safety through the creation and management of a regional structure in Tiraspol town that will provide consumer assistance services in case of legal misconduct, will permanently provide information and advice to consumers, economic agents, state institutions and other stakeholders interested in the field, will organize trainings and other informational events. Thus, as a result of these activities consumers will be more active and informed, and food operators will be more competitive. The Center for Consumer Protection will adhere to the coalition of consumer protection CSOs from Moldova and will share experience and also legal gaps will be identified and ways of eradicating them will be found. Thus, as a result of these activities consumers will be more active and informed,
