PROGRAM 1. CIVIL AND POLITICAL RIGHTS AND DEMOCRATIC GOVERNANCE

COMPONENT 1.1: Civil society participation and oversight

1. AO *Coaliția "Vocea Romilor"*

Project name: "Step by Step Find solutions for Roma in the Republic of Moldova - Voice of Roma Coalition"

Grant amount: **735,071.00 MDL**

Period of implementation: 02/03/2020 – 31/12/2020

The project Step-by-step we find solutions for Roma people in the Republic of Moldova aims to promote the implementation of the commitments of the Government of the Republic of Moldova in the social building of Roma inclusion in accordance with the Government Decision no. 734 of July 2016 "The plan to support the Roma for the year 2016-2020". This action plan is based on the objective of reducing poverty and increasing economic potential, promoting cultural diversity and combating existing negative stereotypes, improving Roma participation in public life. Thus, within the project, the capacities for evaluation and monitoring of public policies aimed at integrating Roma people, in the fields of intervention, (health, education, employment, community mediator), especially from the rural area, will be strengthened. By carrying out joint actions with the participation of the Roma society, the participation and development of the capacities of the Roma non-governmental organizations in the country will be increased by maintaining a platform of dialogue between the Roma NGO and the government. The funding for this project is provided by the Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation and Sweden within "The Joint Equal Opportunity Initiative".

2. AO *"Institutul pentru Drepturile Omului din Moldova"*

Project name: "Human Rights Crisis Center COVID-19"

Grant amount: **20,000.00 EUR**

Period of implementation: 13/05/2020 – 12/09/2020

The purpose of the project is to promote human rights and defend human rights violations in context of COVID 19 pandemic in Republic of Moldova. The project aims to analyse the actions and restrictions of the state towards citizens, during and after the COVID 19 pandemic. The Crisis center will allow various human rights issues of ordinary citizens to be analyzed by experts and lawyers and the information on the issues to be transmitted to authorities, which suddenly in the crisis situation cannot face all social problems. The information sent by IDOM to the authorities will help the state to take faster actions in the situations concerned its citizens. As a result, the government will know better the problems of the citizens and will make decisions to intervene in those situations where it has not yet been able to do so. In case that the government will take no measures on the extremely vital segments for the citizens, the project will put pressure on the authorities for measures to be taken in solving those problems. The funding for this initiative is provided by European Union and Sweden within "Advocacy for better protection against discrimination" project.

3. AO “Institutul pentru Drepturile Omului din Moldova”

Project name: “Strengthening the Platform for Inclusion and Non-Discrimination”

Grant amount: **19,967.00 EUR**

Period of implementation: 01/07/2020 – 30/06/2021

The aim of the project is to strengthen the Platform for Inclusion and Non-Discrimination, by coordinating and mobilizing CSO efforts to defend the principle of equality and combat discrimination. The mission of the Platform is to contribute to the elaboration and consistent application of a non-discriminatory legal framework in the Republic of Moldova, as well as to the promotion of positive international practices on non-discrimination. In order to achieve the goal and mission, the members of IDOM were selected by the members of the Platform as an organization that will host the secretariat of the created platform. The Secretariat will support members of the Inclusion and Non-Discrimination Platform to promote the need for decision-makers to adopt proposals to amend the legislation for better protection against discrimination. The activity of the secretariat will be focused on strengthening and facilitating communication between the members of the Platform for Inclusion and Non-Discrimination as well as between the latter and relevant third parties. The Platform's efforts will be strengthened at raising the awareness of society, including public authorities, on the need to combat discrimination and promote legislative amendments. The funding for this initiative is provided by European Union and Sweden within “Advocacy for better protection against discrimination” project.

4. AO Centrul de Resurse Umane “Dialog-Pro”

Project name: “Strengthening financial sustainability within NGOs by providing methodological support to the development of the internal control system and financial management”

Grant amount: **9,900.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 17/07/2020 – 16/12/2020

The project will contribute to strengthening the financial sustainability of the 5 selected CSOs by providing them with experiences and application practices in the fields of creating and maintaining internal control (IC) and financial management (FM) systems. The project activities are structured within 3 basic objectives that *will be carried out consecutively*: evaluation of the state of the IC and FM systems in each of the selected CSOs; providing methodological support for the development and updating of the targeted systems and training of the management and financial managers of CSOs in 2 thematic modules. The funding for this initiative is provided by Sweden.

COMPONENT 1.3: Free, fair and inclusive elections

5. AO “Asociația pentru Democrație Participativă”

Project name: “Civic Coalition for Free and Fair Elections 2020”

Grant amount: **25,000.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 01/09/2020 – 31/12/2020

The project seeks to contribute to free, fair and inclusive elections in 2020, compliant with the international electoral standards and the human rights commitments of Moldova. In the context of the 2020 local presidential elections, the grantee will host the secretariat of the Civic Coalition for Free and Fair Elections (Coalition) - a platform that unites approximately 30 NGOs. The Secretariat will facilitate internal and external communication of the Coalition members, ensuring its good functioning. The project will strengthen the communication and outreach capacities of the Coalition. The initiative will facilitate civil society advocacy for democratic elections, ensuring that continuous awareness of citizens, electoral bodies, electoral candidates, donors and other relevant stakeholders about the 2020 presidential suffrage. The funding for this initiative is provided by Sweden.

6. Asociația Obștească de Beneficiari a Consumatorilor de Apă "Acva-Chircăieș"

Project name: "Creation of a social workshop for recruiting marginalized people from Chircăieștii Noi village in technological education activities"

Grant amount: **440,035.00 MDL**

Period of implementation: 02/01/2020 – 31/12/2020

The project aims to create a social enterprise which would gather marginalized groups of people (women, young people, people with disabilities, pensioners), where they could get knowledge in various technological issues as well as in civil and social matters, with participation of the whole community (APL, Gimnaziu Chircăieștii Noi, economic agents). The purpose of the action is to increase the capacity of locality and create favorable circumstances for its sustainable development. Another objective of the project is to promote the rights of the inhabitants of the village and, as a result, to be involved in the decision-making process at the local level, purpose for which advocacy actions will be carried out. This project targets a total number of 907 people, of which 523 women, 265 pensioners, of which 165 women, 38 students (of the 7th, 8th, 9th grade), 22 people with disabilities and 59 young people, who will know their rights and the possibilities of involvement into decision-making process at local level, as well as advocacy means to defend their rights and request solutions for locally identified problems. The funding for this initiative is provided by the Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation and Sweden within "The Joint Equal Opportunity Initiative".

7. AO a Pedagogilor și Părinților "Speranța"

Project name: "Together we reduce the risks"

Grant amount: **342,663.00 MDL**

Period of implementation: 02/01/2020 – 31/01/2021

This project aims to create a Local Participation Council (LPC), which will work together with Taraclia Local Council on reducing risks faced by disadvantaged families in the locality. The Taraclia Local Participation Council (TLPC) will analyze policies and decisions of LPA and other state institutions in the locality, which target disadvantaged families. 10 most vulnerable families in the locality will be the target beneficiaries of the project. Psycho-pedagogical support will be organized for all identified target beneficiaries. Thus, the project will integrate social actors into the community, which will defend the interests of young disadvantaged parents through the Local Participation Council, which will include members from all organizations: Association of teachers and parents "Speranta", Theoretical Lyceum "Stefan cel Mare si Sfint" Taraclia, Multifunctional center Concordia, Social centre "Home where I feel child", NGO "Plai Natal" and NGO "Ghiocel". During 13 months, young parents will receive methodological assistance, and will be closely involved into various workshops with their children. As a result, in 10 the most marginalized families of Taraclia, situation will improve, particularly in assuming responsibilities by each member of the family. The funding for this initiative is provided by the Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation and Sweden within "The Joint Equal Opportunity Initiative".

8. AO “CoNatal-Neo”

Project name: “Involved community – a way to common well-being”

Grant amount: **668,250.00 MDL**

Period of implementation: 03/02/2020 – 02/02/2021

This project aims to increase the local civic activism in the village of Opaci r. Căușeni, by increasing the level of information, participation and involvement of the community, especially marginalized groups into decision-making process. Participation of citizens in the decision-making process, ensuring access to information on activity of public authorities, but also of public officials, are rights guaranteed and ensured by the legal framework of the Republic of Moldova. However, these fundamental rights are very little known by the members of the communities in Opaci, especially members of vulnerable groups, such as elderly, people with disabilities, unemployed, women and young people. As result, the project targets about 60 vulnerable people, who will be identified for mobilization and participation in solving community problems, particularly budgetary ones. The funding for this initiative is provided by the Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation and Sweden within “The Joint Equal Opportunity Initiative”.

9. Asociația Națională a Para-juriștilor din Republica Moldova

Project name: “Creșterea incluziunii sociale a foștilor deținuți prin intermediul mobilizării comunitare”

Grant amount: **728,138.00 MDL**

Period of implementation: 01/06/2020 – 31/05/2021

The project aims to contribute to the social inclusion of former detainees through their legal empowerment, their involvement in community life, changing the negative perception of society towards this vulnerable group. Within this project, the ANPM team will be a facilitator between the former detainees, society and the state. The association of para-jurists through specialized para-jurists and para-jurists (9 of the 51 para-jurists also having the status of ex-detainees, who have been successfully rehabilitated, have developed professional skills and can help others to reintegrate socially, which are a role model for others) will communicate more effectively with the target group targeted in this project, which will contribute to their social inclusion through project activities. The funding for this initiative is provided by the Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation and Sweden within “The Joint Equal Opportunity Initiative”.

COMPONENT 2.2: Youth and Education

10. Благотворительный Фонд «Сердце»

Project name: “Молодёжный Фонд Бендеры 2020”

Grant amount: **15,000.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 03/02/2020 – 30/11/2020

The aim of the project is to provide young people, in the city of Bender, the opportunity to become active change agents in the development of their communities. The key idea of youth participation is to give young people the opportunity to influence those issues that directly affect their daily lives, they can be implemented both through participation in decision-making with adults and through their own activities that have a positive impact on the environment. The funding for this initiative is provided by Sweden.

COMPONENT 2.3: Social Inclusion of vulnerable groups

11. AO "Budești – Casa Părintească"

Project name: "Dad, mom and kids"

Grant amount: **14,733.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 02/01/2020 – 30/06/2020

The project aims to support and promote the participation of men and women from Budești, Chisinau City, in the process of childcare and spread of the principle of equal sharing of family responsibilities by men and women, including those affected by migration, through a range of informational, educational, community mobilization activities. It involves at least 30 fathers, 30 mothers and 50 upperclassmen of the local high school. The funding for this initiative is provided by the OAK Foundation.

12. AO "Pro Cimișlia"

Project name: "50/50: Equal rights, equal responsibilities"

Grant amount: **14,909.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 02/01/2020 – 30/12/2020

The project aims to cultivate the positive attitude of the future and existent parents in the process of development / caring for children through their improved educational skills, resulted from a set of directed and comprehensive communication activities in order to change the behavior and attitudes, regarding the active role of men in housework and family. It should bring this topic on the public agenda of local public authorities and sectoral specialists to join forces for this purpose and increase their capacities. The funding for this initiative is provided by the OAK Foundation.

13. AO "Viitor, Integritate, Perspectivă – VIP CENTRU"

Project name: "Promoting men in children's education and equitable division of household tasks."

Grant amount: **14,880.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 02/01/2020 – 30/06/2021

The aim of the project is to train families in Cantemir localities to provide quality education for children and to raise awareness of the importance of gender equality inside the family and society. This will be achieved through informational seminars, parents' clubs and workshops with children, teenagers and young people, as well as activities that will directly contribute to building a family-friendly psychological climate and the involvement of fathers in cultural and educational activities. At the end of the project, a minimum of 10 parent clubs and a minimum of 300 persons trained on gender equality and non-violent family education will be established. The funding for this initiative is provided by the OAK Foundation.

14. AO "Centrul de Asistență Socială Casa Speranțelor"

Project name: "Communication for Change: more harmony and less violence".

Grant amount: **15,000.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 02/01/2020 – 31/12/2020

The project aims to increase the importance of paternity, to promote the participation of men in the process of childcare and equal sharing of household responsibilities by men and women. Representatives of different community structures, educational institutions and parents will be informed and sensitized about the importance of active participation of both parents in children

education, gender equality and reduction of violence inside the family and society. The funding for this initiative is provided by the OAK Foundation.

15. AO "Centrul Media pentru Tineri"

Project name: "Promoting good practices of father involvement in family life and in the education of children, through media tools"

Grant amount: **60,000.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 02/01/2020 – 30/06/2021

Through this project, the AO "Centrul Media pentru Tineri" and the online media platform www.Suntparinte.md aim at increasing the level of information and awareness regarding the importance of fatherhood and childcare process participation of men, on promoting equal sharing of family responsibilities by men and women that refer to combating existing stereotypes. The funding for this initiative is provided by the OAK Foundation.

16. AO "Sud-Est Media"

Project name: National media campaign "Be like a Dad to your child"

Grant amount: **50,000.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 01/02/2020 – 31/03/2021

AO "Sud-Est Media" intends to implement a national campaign through Moldova.org multimedia news and reporting portal it manages, to raise society awareness regarding the involvement of men in children education and domestic activities. The long-term goal of the project is to create a tendency among fathers in the regions to spend more time with their children and to share responsibilities with their partners. It is desired to increase the long-term awareness of gender equality through the activities organized in the regions, and to motivate communities and authorities to promote and consolidate changes that have occurred in family gender roles. The funding for this initiative is provided by the OAK Foundation.

17. AO Centrul de Intervenție Precoce "Voinicel"

Project name: "Prevention of violence and neglect of the child by implementing positive parenting programs in the Republic of Moldova."

Grant amount: **44,981.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 01/01/2020 – 31/12/2020

This project aims at increasing parenting knowledge and skills of about 140 parents, both mothers and fathers, by development, implementing and positive parenting programs in 6 centers of Early Intervention in the country to reduce the phenomenon of violence and neglect of children from Moldova. As a result, this project will improve knowledge, but above all, it will bring about positive attitudes and commitments of both fathers and mothers, so that they recognize the responsibility of raising "wonderful" children, promoting joy, love without violence at home. The funding for this initiative is provided by the OAK Foundation.

18. AO Filiala din Moldova a Asociației Amici dei Bambini

Project name: "Fathers aware and responsible for a non-violent generation"

Grant amount: **57,275.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 01/01/2020 – 30/06/2021

The action here aims at promoting a non-violent environment for raising and educating children through adequate involvement of fathers in family life. Emphasis will be placed on adoptive families in MR, with children who suffered trauma of abandonment and neglect, who have difficulties in

creating a secure and lasting attachment, and who require special attention from both parents, depending on age, sex and the trauma they have experienced previously. There will be actions at individual, interpersonal, community, organizational and policy levels, through the proposed activities. There will be modifications of the normative framework to regulate training, evaluation of the future adoptive parents, as well as monitoring and post-adoptive support. It will be adapted with more emphasis on equitable division of roles in the family, on non-violent education styles, based on gender equality. The funding for this initiative is provided by the OAK Foundation.

19. AO "Principii Sănătoase"

Project name: "The school of paternity!"

Grant amount: **12,219.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 15/01/2020 – 14/07/2020

The project aims to train trainers from 10 Youth Resource Centers in the North, South and Center regions of Moldova Republic, who will, subsequently, train and assist young people in understanding and raising awareness of paternity, family tasks and childcare responsibilities, with respect to gender equality, co-participation in childcare, as well as, promoting appropriate gender norms. The Youth Resource Centers will provide information and enhance the level of young people' competence in childcare that will lead to achieving emergent social and behavioral changes in the younger generations of Moldova Republic. This will help prevent gender-based violence, while also creating a favorable environment for strengthening family relationships. As a result, young people from the North, South and Central regions of Moldova Republic respect the rights regarding gender equality, co-participate and promote good childcare practices in society. The funding for this initiative is provided by the OAK Foundation.

20. Fundația pentru Educația Non-Formală

Project name: "PEACE (Sharing, Education, Commitment, Cooperation, Equality)"

Grant amount: **50,165.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 01/02/2020 – 28/02/2021

The PEACE project aims to train 3,000 students, grades 9-12, within 150 trainings in rural localities in 20 districts of MR, on equal distribution of family roles, through 30 trainers formed within the project. As a result of the project and evaluation of the training program by students, the Foundation for Non-Formal Education will apply to an international exchange of Erasmus + experience, with the subject being gender equality and role distribution in families from different EU countries. The funding for this initiative is provided by the OAK Foundation.

21. AO "Areopagus"

Project name: "A good father is worth a thousand teachers"

Grant amount: **14,982.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 15/01/2020 – 14/09/2020

The project aims to train men from Floresti in educating children, as well as their involvement in the distribution of household tasks. The project, by its planned activities, comes to address the family with all its problems in a complex way: poor communication, violence, lack of attention from parents and mutual between spouses, which, in turn, lead to underdevelopment of children and growth of an incompatible generation to social conditions. The funding for this initiative is provided by the OAK Foundation.

22. AO "Asociația Împotriva Violenței în Familie - Casa Mărioarei"

Project name: "Dad's school"

Grant amount: **59,507.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 15/01/2020 – 15/01/2021

The long-term goal of the project is to prevent domestic violence by promoting the involvement of men in growing and educating children and in sharing responsibilities. The core activities are focused on identifying gender promoters among men and women, future and existent fathers, in order to create a group of leaders (future trainers), who will become a powerful source of education for other groups of men and fathers. It also includes training within "School for fathers: Father School", in order to deepen their knowledge in the field of gender equality and understand the role of fathers in growing and educating children, and their involvement in home activities. The funding for this initiative is provided by the OAK Foundation.

23. AO "Clubul Femeilor Golubca"

Project name: "Dad, Mom and me - a great family!"

Grant amount: **14,375.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 15/01/2020 – 14/07/2020

The project goal is to raise awareness of equal opportunities between men and women, as well as raising public awareness of sharing household responsibilities among citizens from Basarabeasca and Comrat. The funding for this initiative is provided by the OAK Foundation.

24. Uniunea de Persoane Juridice "Asociația Micilor Producători și Procesatori de Fructe și Bacifere din Regiunea Centru"

Project name: "Initiating a social enterprise to manufacture vegetable packaging of food products for export."

Grant amount: **20,000.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 03/02/2020 – 30/11/2020

The goal of the project is sustainable development of the localities that are facing the problem of aging population and the social degradation of the people who do not have a stable job, by creating two viable social enterprises that will produce environmentally degradable packaging engaging people with special needs. The funding for this initiative is provided by Sweden.

25. AO "Centrul Național de Prevenire a Abuzului față de Copii" (CNPAC)

Project name: "Increasing social inclusion and access to specialized recovery services of child who are victims of violence and abuse"

Grant amount: **19,995.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 03/02/2020 – 30/11/2020

The goal of the project is to successfully reintegrate the most vulnerable children in the society, by ensuring the access of children - victims of violence to specialized recovery services and diminishing the effects / consequences of the abuses they have been subjected to. The funding for this initiative is provided by Sweden.

26. AO "Acțiunea pentru Dezvoltare"

Project name: "Playground for kids"

Grant amount: **4,213.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 03/02/2020 – 02/07/2020

The goal of the project is to offer access to healthy and recreation environment for the children from Hirtop Mic Village, by equipping a playground on the school territory. The funding for this initiative is provided by Sweden.

27. AO "Concordia"

Project name: "Creating an Inclusive Community Center, offering Snoezelen Therapy services, speech therapy and psychotherapy for children with special needs"

Grant amount: **19,998.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 03/02/2020 – 30/11/2020

The goal of the project is to provide access for children with severe disabilities from Telenesti district, aged between 3-14 years, in number 45, to specific quality services, by creating and equipping a center, within which the following services will be provided: Snoezelen therapy, psychotherapy, speech therapy for children with special needs. The funding for this initiative is provided by Sweden.

28. AO Centrul de Intervenție Precoce "Voinicel"

Project name: "Capacity building and development of partnerships for fostering the social inclusion of children with disabilities"

Grant amount: **20,000.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 03/02/2020 – 30/11/2020

The goal of the project is to strengthen and consolidate knowledge and skills of parents and pedagogical staff in pre-school institutions to facilitate the harmonious development and social inclusion of the children with special needs. The funding for this initiative is provided by Sweden.

29. AO "Your Right"

Project name: "Support to Vulnerable Groups in Republic of Moldova"

Grant amount: **19,905.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 03/02/2020 – 30/11/2020

The goal of the project is to facilitate the psychological-social integration of the children that are victims of sexual violence from the central regions of the country (Ialoveni, Strășeni, Criuleni, Anenii Noi, Orhei). This initiative will consolidate the knowledge of the social assistants from LPA regarding their role in approaching these kind of sexual abuse cases through organizing a series of informational seminars. Along these activities, efforts will be undertaken to facilitate the access to legal and psychological assistance for the children victims through offering necessary services. The funding for this initiative is provided by Sweden.

30. AO "SOS Autism"

Project name: "Access to vocational services for disadvantaged young people with autism from Moldova"

Grant amount: **20,000.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 03/02/2020 – 30/11/2020

The goal of the project is to facilitate the social and professional inclusion of disadvantaged young people, including those with autism from the Republic of Moldova during the implementation of the

project by creating and equipping the vocational workshop for candle making and pottery. The funding for this initiative is provided by Sweden.

31. AO "Asociația Copiilor Surzi din Moldova"

Project name: "Beekeeping - an opportunity for occupational integration, entrepreneurial training and professional orientation of young people with disabilities in the Republic of Moldova"

Grant amount: **9,900.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 13/04/2020 – 12/10/2020

The purpose of this project is to facilitate the process of social integration of young people with disabilities. In order to reach the goal, the association intends to create favorable working conditions for the young employees at the "Darul albinelor" hive. In this sense, a modular construction (box) will be purchased and installed on the territory of the hive. The beekeeping equipment will be installed in the construction. A workshop will be set up where the young people will deal with the extraction and packaging of bee products, as well as other necessary works. The house will have all the necessary utilities (washbasin, toilet). Also, in the construction there will be a warehouse for keeping the collected bee products. During the free time the young people will have the opportunity to discuss, serve a tea and also to be informed about the field of beekeeping from the proposed materials (guides, books, computer). A couple of meetings with the employed beekeeper expert will be organized. The funding for this initiative is provided by Sweden.

32. НП «Агентство инноваций и развития»

Project name: "Support to young entrepreneurs (participants of Startup Academy 2.0)"

Grant amount: **5,000.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 01/06/2020 – 30/09/2020

The project aims to increase the economic activity of SMEs in the regions and contribute to a more sustainable economic development in Moldova through active involvement of civil society and other socio-economic actors with due consideration to Association Agreement and DCFTA. The activities are designed to support, coach and accelerate the economic activity of 5 SMEs from Transnistrian region through seed funding. Business Support Hub from Tiraspol will serve as an effective mean of supporting private initiative and will help to strengthen public-private partnerships in meeting the sustainable development goals of communities and regions. As a result, SMEs will access business development services being empowered to benefit new economic opportunities in relation to DCFTA. The funding for this initiative is provided by Sweden.

33. AO "Asociația Muzical-Corală"

Project name: "La La Play Voices Academy, 3rd edition"

Grant amount: **23,958.00 USD**

Period of implementation: 10/07/2020 – 09/12/2020

The project goal is to contribute to the improvement of the quality of life of talented children from socially vulnerable groups by empowering them with knowledge, attitudes, confidence in their own strengths and visions of personal and professional development. The initiative is a continuation of the initiative from 2017 of the "Hear My Voice Choir" pilot project, which this time will gather together in a choir of 130 children and adolescents from the last editions, together with other 50 girls and 50 boys aged 12-17 years from 32 rayons of the Republic of Moldova from this year. The initiative will spread all over the country including the left bank of Nistru River and Gagauz Yeri. The project will end with a national concert that will
